3 JESUS TOLD THEM TO GO SHOW THEMSELVES TO THE PRIESTS. AS THEY WENT, THEY WERE HEALED!



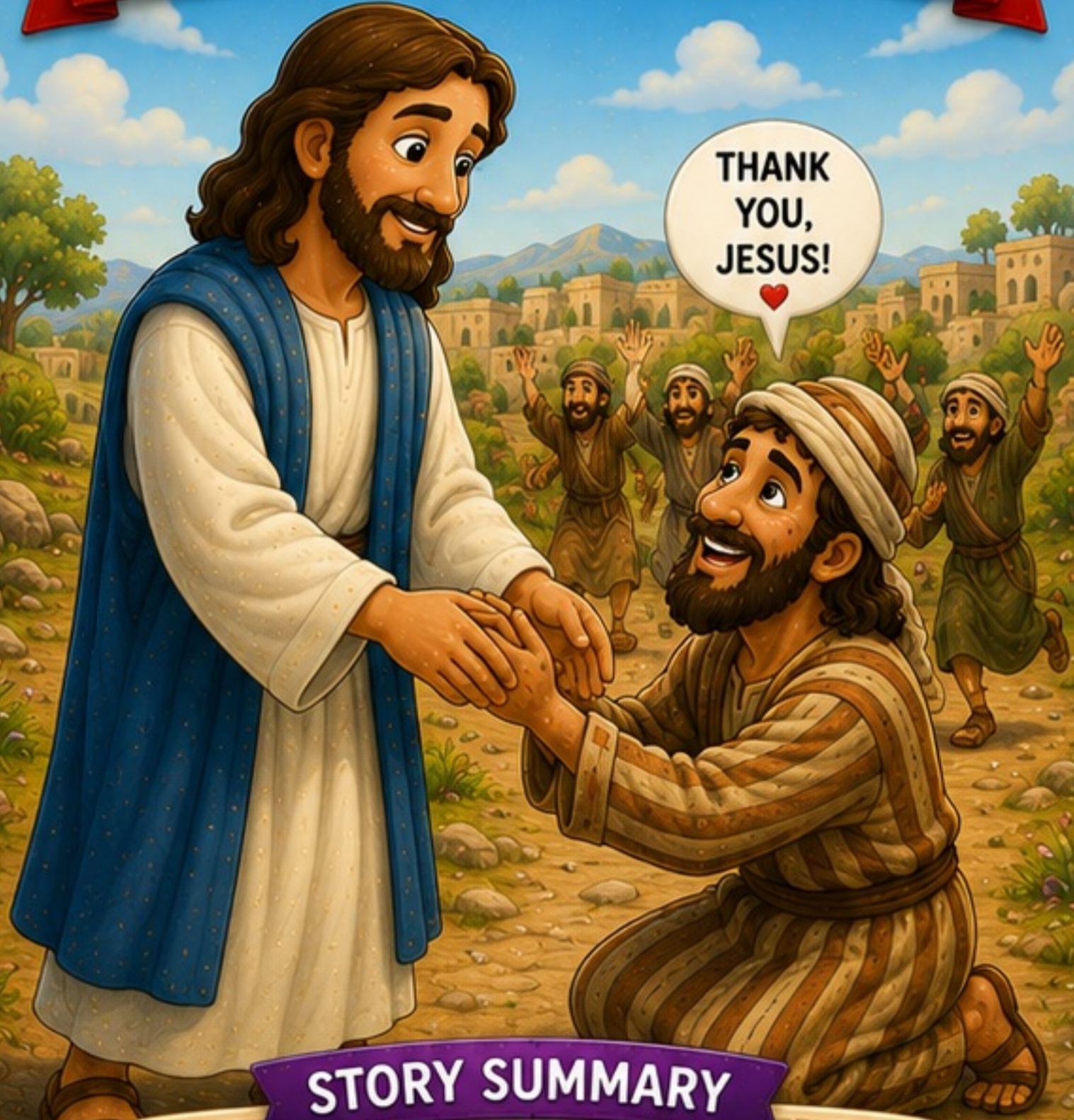
4 ALL TEN WERE HEALED! THEY WERE SO HAPPY THAT THEY RAN AWAY TO CELEBRATE.

6 JESUS SAID, "YOUR FAITH HAS MADE YOU WELL." THEN HE PRAISED GOD FOR THE THANKFUL MAN.



STORY SUMMARY

Jesus healed ten men who had leprosy. All of them were made well, but only one returned to say thank you. Jesus was happy to see that one man was grateful. He told him that his faith had made him well. This story shows how important it is to be thankful for the blessings we receive.

3 NOAH WORKED FOR MANY YEARS. FINALLY, THE ARK WAS FINISHED.



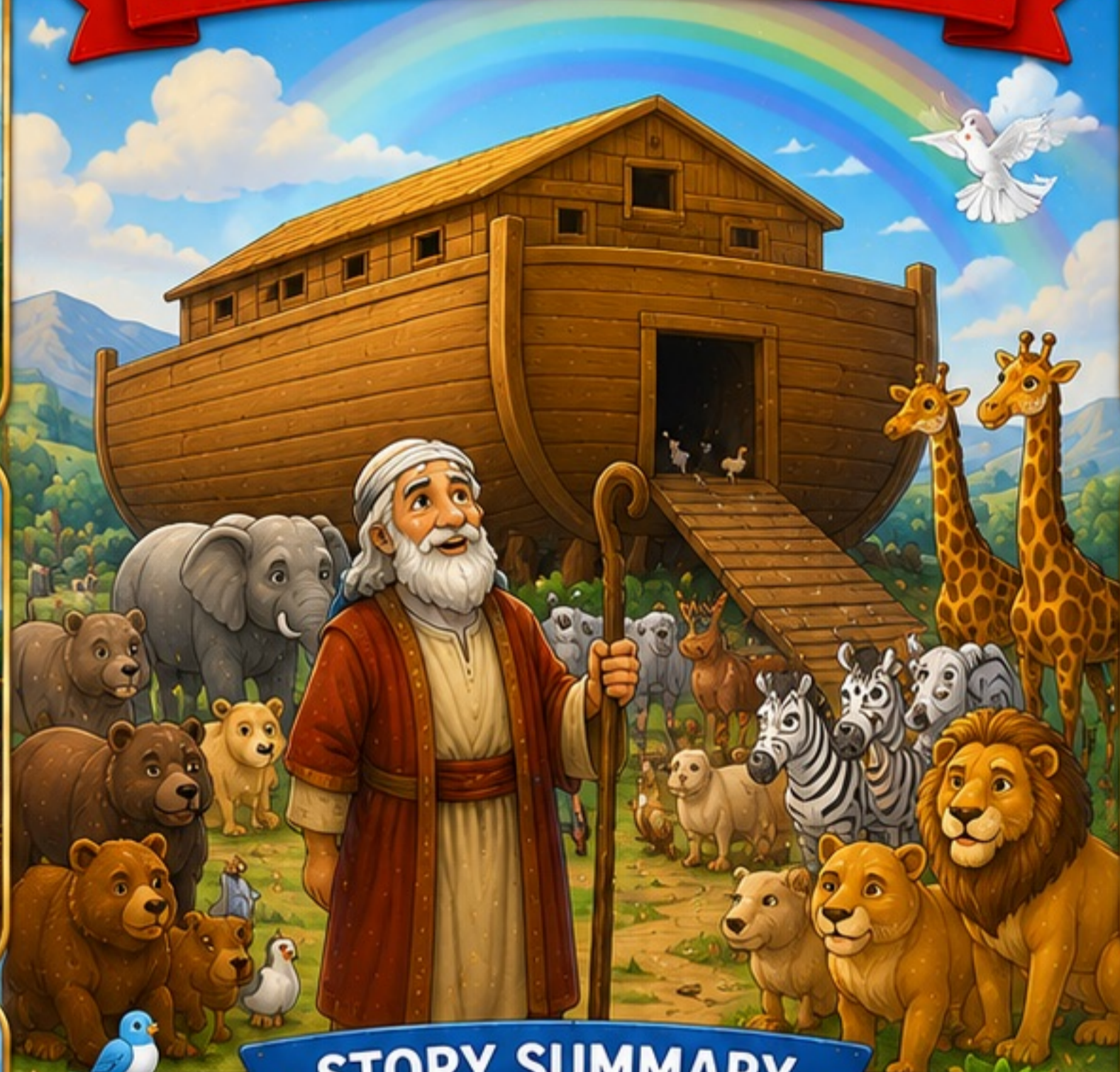
4 THEN THE RAIN CAME! WATER COVERED THE EARTH FOR MANY DAYS.



5 NOAH, HIS FAMILY, AND THE ANIMALS WERE SAFE INSIDE THE ARK.



6 WHEN THE FLOOD ENDED, NOAH AND HIS FAMILY CAME OUT, AND GOD PROMISED NEVER TO DESTROY THE EARTH AGAIN.



STORY SUMMARY

God saw that people were doing wrong things. He told Noah about the flood and asked him to build an ark. Noah obeyed, even when others made fun of him. When the flood came, Noah, his family, and the animals were safe inside the ark. Noah's obedience protected many lives, and God made a beautiful promise.

2 THEY SOLD HIM INTO SLAVERY AND HE WENT TO EGYPT. But God was with Joseph every step of the way.



5 JOSEPH COULD HAVE PUNISHED THEM, BUT HE CHOSE FORGIVENESS. He spoke kindly to them and provided for their needs.



3 JOSEPH WORKED HARD AND BECAME A LEADER IN EGYPT. God blessed him.



STORY SUMMARY

Joseph's brothers were jealous and sold him into slavery. God was with Joseph, and he became a leader in Egypt. When his brothers came to Egypt during a famine, Joseph forgave them instead of punishing them. He helped them and reunited their family. Joseph showed that forgiveness is more powerful than revenge.

6 JOSEPH REUNITED WITH HIS BROTHERS AND HIS FAMILY. They embraced with joy and thankfulness.

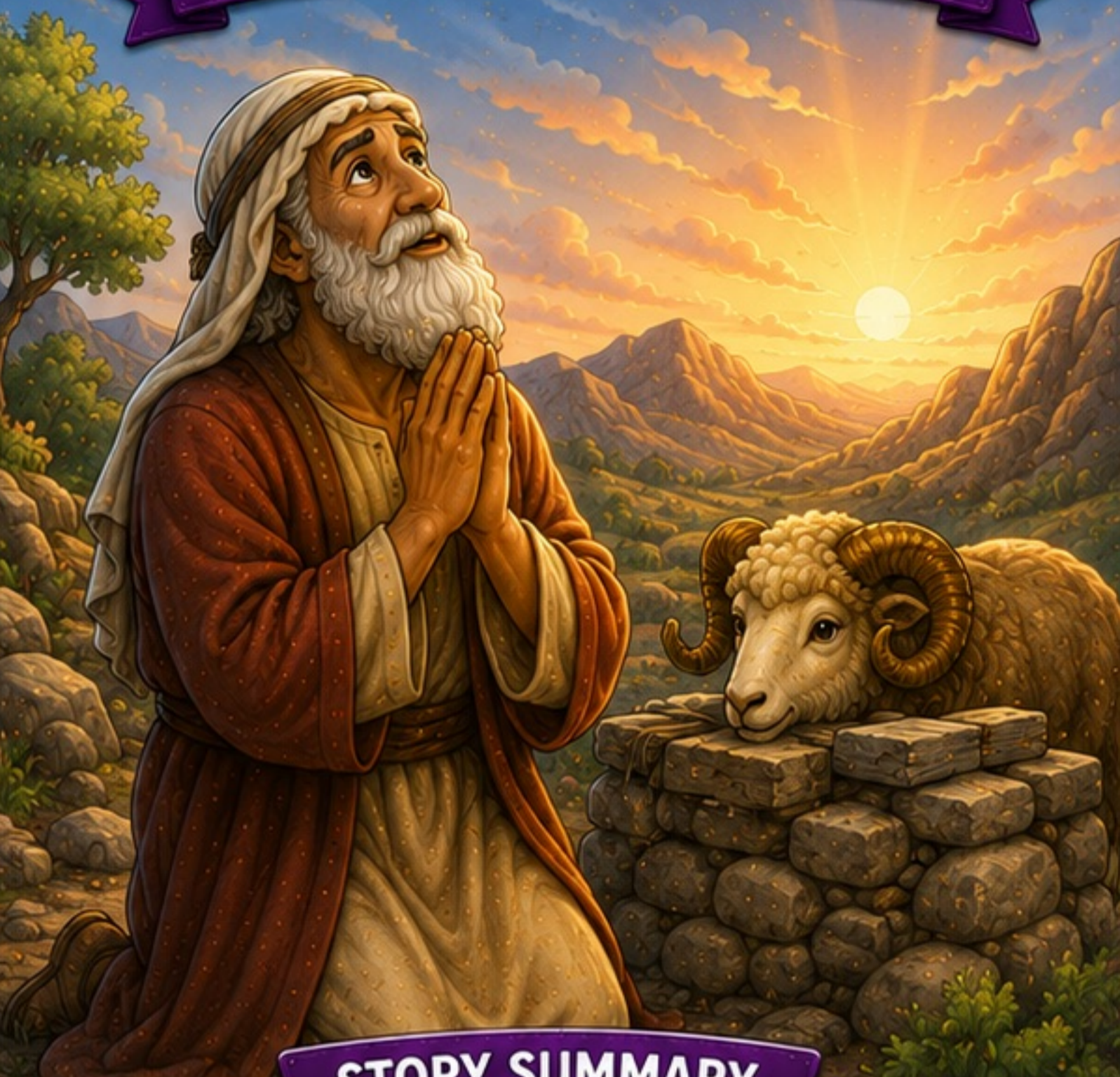

5 ZACCHAEUS' HEART CHANGED. HE ADMITTED HIS MISTAKES AND PROMISED TO REPAY ANYONE HE HAD CHEATED.



6 ZACCHAEUS GAVE HALF OF HIS POSSESSIONS TO THE POOR AND BECAME AN HONEST AND KIND MAN.



STORY SUMMARY

Zacchaeus was a dishonest tax collector who took more money than he should. When Jesus came to town, Zacchaeus climbed a tree to see Him. Jesus called Zacchaeus by name and went to his house. Zacchaeus' heart changed. He admitted his wrongs, promised to repay those he cheated, and gave to the poor. Jesus brings change and a new beginning to anyone who truly wants it.



BEDTIME LESSON:

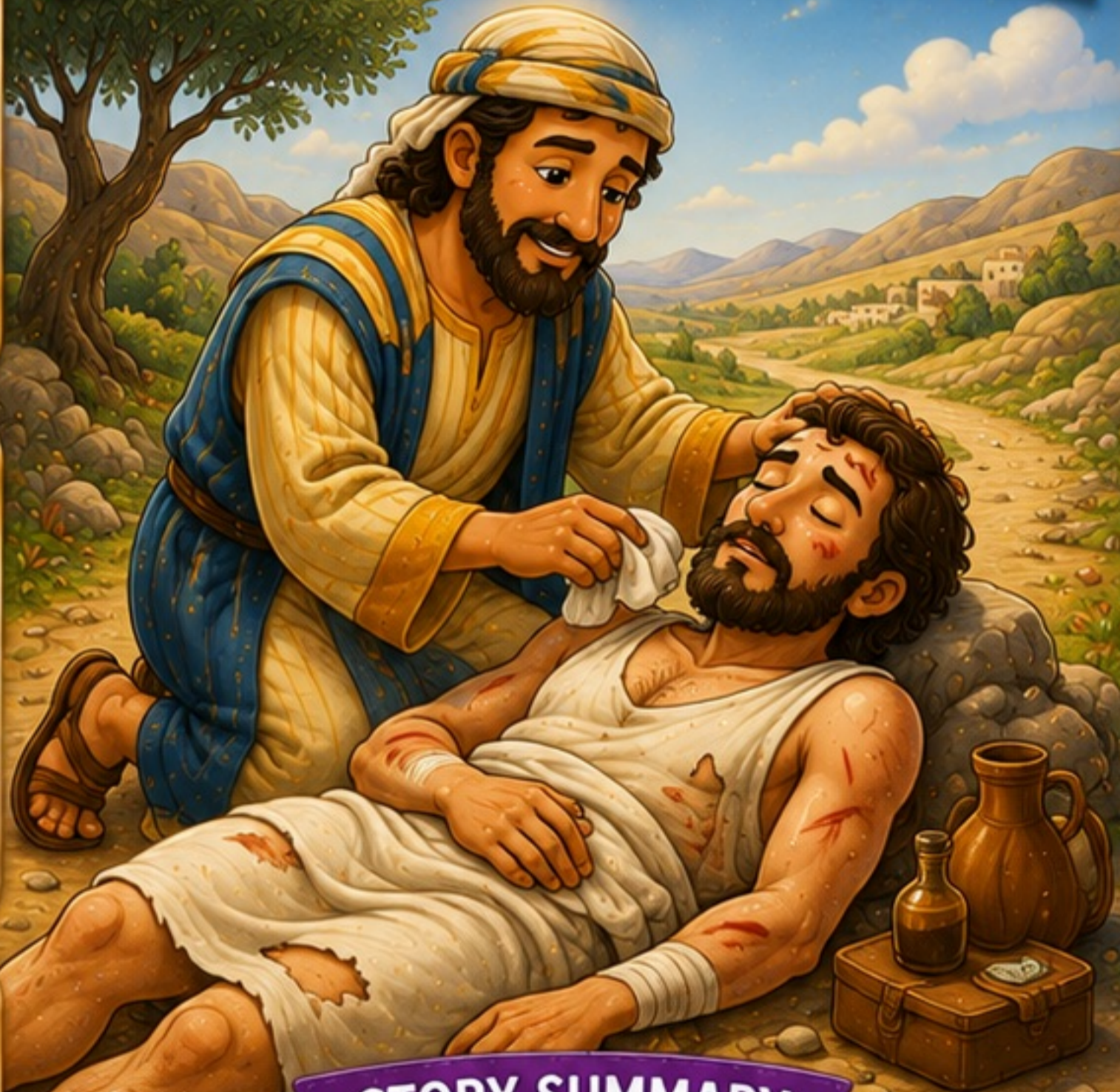

STORY SUMMARY

Jesus told the story of a man who was hurt by robbers and left by the road. Many people passed by without helping. But a Samaritan showed kindness. He cared for the man and paid for his care. Jesus taught that we should love and help anyone who needs us.

God chose Moses to lead the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt.
Moses trusted God, even when it was hard.
God performed many miracles, and the greatest was
parting the Red Sea. The Israelites walked through
on dry ground and were set free.
God protected them and led them to a new beginning.

Daniel continued to pray to God and was thrown into the lions' den. That night, God protected Daniel, and the lions did not hurt him at all. The next morning, Daniel was found safe and healthy. Everyone praised God for His power and protection.



4 DANIEL WAS THROWN INTO THE LIONS' DEN AS PUNISHMENT.



5 THAT NIGHT, GOD PROTECTED DANIEL. THE LIONS DID NOT HARM HIM AT ALL.

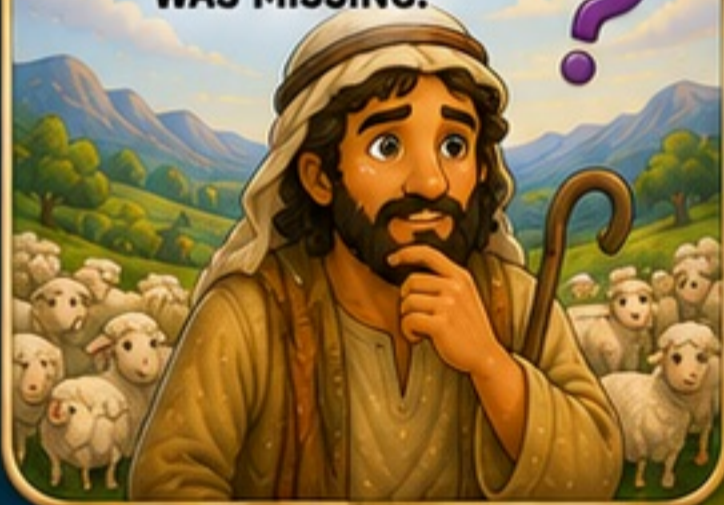

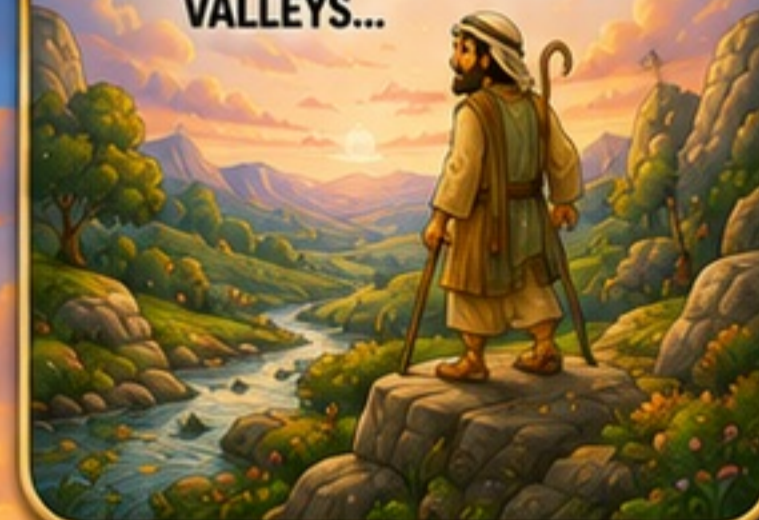


3 HE LEFT THE NINETY-NINE IN A SAFE PLACE AND WENT TO LOOK FOR THE LOST SHEEP.

3 WHEN THE ARK WAS READY, NOAH BROUGHT HIS FAMILY AND TWO OF EVERY KIND OF ANIMAL ABOARD.



4 SOON, RAIN BEGAN TO FALL AND CONTINUED FOR FORTY DAYS AND NIGHTS. THE ARK FLOATED SAFELY ON THE WATER.

5 AFTER MANY MONTHS, THE WATERS DISAPPEARED, AND NOAH'S FAMILY STEPPED ONTO DRY LAND.

6 GOD PLACED A BEAUTIFUL RAINBOW IN THE SKY AS A PROMISE OF HIS LOVE AND FAITHFULNESS.

STORY SUMMARY



Noah was a good man who trusted God in a time when people were not kind or obeying Him. God told Noah to build an ark because a great flood was coming. Noah, his family, and two of every animal were saved in the ark. After the flood, God kept His promise and put a rainbow in the sky as a sign of His love.



BEDTIME LESSON:

He knows each of them by name, and they know his voice.

5 JESUS IS OUR GOOD SHEPHERD.



He loves us, cares for us, and will never leave us.

6 WE CAN TRUST JESUS EVERY DAY.



No matter what happens, Jesus is always with us.



STORY SUMMARY




Jesus said that He is like a good shepherd who takes care of His sheep. He protects them from danger, guides them to safe places, and knows each one by name. Jesus loves us very much and will never leave us. We can always trust Him to care for us.

STORY SUMMARY
